





CANDIDATE INVITATION TO ON-DEMAND EXEMPLIFICATION

The On-Demand ceremony can be accessed by candidates online 24 hours a day. Other scheduled ceremonies are announced in the Online Exemplification tab. Before inviting a candidate to participate in the On-Demand ceremony, make sure your council has completed their standard admissions process and has collected the information needed for his form 100. Councils must file a Form 100 for all candidates who complete an online exemplification.






2022 – 2022 Fraternal Year The Star Council Award recognizes outstanding achievement in membership, insurance and programming. In order to achieve the Star Council Award, a council must earn the Father McGivney,

Founder's, and Columbian Awards.



Father McGivney Award



This award recognizes excellence in your council's membership growth. To win this award your council must meet or exceed its yearly membership quota. The quota for 2021-2022 is 5% net increase in the council's membership as of July 1, (minimum of three and maximum of twenty).




Founder's Award



This award recognizes excellence in your council's promotion of our top-rated insurance products. To win this award your council must host two approved Fraternal Benefit Seminars, in conjunction with your Field Agent or General Agent.



Columbian Award



This award recognizes excellence in your council's programming and charitable outreach. To earn this award your council must conduct and report programs in each of the four program categories (Faith, Family, Community, and Life) for a total of 16 program credits, with four in each category.

No required programs this year.

Some programs count for two credits.



Star Council Required Forms

Complete and send **required forms** to Supreme and the Texas State Office, forms@tkofc.org

- Submit the Service Program Personnel Report (form 365) due by August 1, 2021.
- Submit the Annual Survey of Fraternal Activity (form 1728) due by January 31, 2022.
- Complete the Columbian Award Application (form SP-7) due by June 30, 2022.



Praesidium (the Order's Safe Environment partner) will send notifications to those men who are required to complete Safe Environment training and to provide authorization for a background check for the Family and Community Directors. This year you must have at least THREE men in these roles.


- Grand Knight (can ONLY hold one other position if needed)
- Program Director
- Family Director
- Community Director

This email will include their unique username and password to access the training website.



- All three modules only take about 2.5 hours to complete.
- The Family and Community Directors must also consent to a background check.
- Individuals will have 30 days to complete the training.
- A warning email reminder will be sent after 2 weeks if not completed.
- If not completed within 30 days, the Director position is vacated and another individual needs to be assigned.

- All four men are compliant.
- Remember, three men are required at a minimum this year. The GK can only hold one other position.
- Training start date depends on when 185 and 365 forms sent to Supreme.
- Training is NOW good for three years.
- Keep an eye on when training expires so refresher training can be completed.
- Only the Family and Community Directors are required to have a background check. The GK opted to have one in this case.



- Once completed, training is good for three years before renewal is required.
- The Grand Knight can be removed from his position for refusing to complete Safe Environment requirements. We need 100% trained this Fall.
- Completing the online safe environment training modules demonstrates commitment to protecting children and vulnerable members.





FEATURED PROGRAMS

The Supreme Council has designated select programs as featured programs in each of the four program categories. When your council conducts a featured program and satisfies the associated requirements it will receive two credits towards that program category on the <u>Columbian Award Application</u> (#SP-7). At the end of the year, report all completed programs on the <u>Annual Survey of Fraternal Activity</u> (#1728). For additional Featured Program information, review the individual program guide sheets found at <u>kofc.org/fiaresources</u>. All program forms may be found at <u>kofc.org/fiaforms</u>.

FAITH

REFUND SUPPORT VOCATIONS PROGRAM (RSVP)

For every \$500 given to an individual seminarian or religious aspirant, Supreme will refund the council or assembly \$100, with a maximum refund of \$400 per individual supported. Report activity using the RSVP Refund Application (#2863).

HOLY HOUR

Councils are required to hold at least four Holy Hours (quarterly). Report activity using the <u>Program</u> (#10784).

INTO THE BREACH

Councils are required to hold eight sessions to discuss the content of either the Into the Breach video series or apostolic exhortation (#340). Report activity using the *Program Report Form* (#10784).


Every Program is an opportunity for every Knight to put their Faith in Action and step Into the Breach.

Councils are required to hold 8 sessions to discuss the content of the video.

Virtual/remote programs will be counted in the same manner that they would have been if conducted completely in person. But can only be counted as once, not twice (in person and virtual).

WORKING WITH YOUR PASTOR

In Brief:

Have you ever struggled to have a good relationship with your pastor? Do you sometimes feel like you've tried everything but you and he don't see things eye to eye?

Consider the fact that this may be as simple as not understanding each other's intentions compounded by not communicating in ways that are mutually clear and beneficial.

Knights of Columbus councils are to be in service to the pastor and thereby the parish. While you may know this, has this been expressed (consistently) to your pastor?

Much like yourself, the pastor is extremely busy and in most cases he is being pulled in countless directions. He doesn't need more work, he needs more help. Who better than the Knights of Columbus to be in direct service to him?

Take Action:

Request to meet with your pastor and explain to him that your council's primary purpose is to be in service to him and the parish.

This needs to be expressed (and more importantly shown) repeatedly & consistently.

If not, everything else you try to accomplish at the parish will be a struggle.

Help him to understand what your council can offer to the parish!

If a pastor doesn't want to engage with your council, it's often because he doesn't understand what you can offer or he has had bad experiences in the past. Most pastors will have preconceived ideas of the Knights (good and bad).

Dues Exemption:

In Member Management the Financial Secretary can go in under the member and mark the member as Seminarian, Disable, or Active Military and his dues will be waived.

A letter to councils will no longer be generated for the Financial Secretary to attest to the renewal of Exemption for a member.

If a member is no longer eligible for Exemption – Disability, Seminarian, or Active Military – the Financial Secretary will need to remove the Exemption status of the member in Member Management.

Additionally, the annual job to remove members from Exemption that are not renewed will no longer be run, the only way to remove a member from Exemption is for the Financial Secretary to update the member's record, when they no longer are eligible for Exemption Status.
